The History





The Madrona wine all started by a pioneer who found an exceptional landscape that is divestible to the hillside vineyard, which was located in El Dorado, California in 1973. It was originally founded by the Senior Bush who wanted to create this unique wine that has great acidity with perfect balance to create this comfort when drinking the wine. This authentic wine was discovered from a 350 year old Madrona tree, which represented the location to grow the best terroir of the Madrona vineyards. These Madrona trees are found in the greatest growing regions through El Dorado, Sierra Foothills AVAs.



The Grape

57% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Merlot, 9% Petite Verdot, 9% Malbec, 16 % Cabernet Francs



Tasting Note

The aromas are a complex myriad of dark cherry and fresh plum. With Cabernet Franc making up 16% of the blend, the savory and slight floral spice comes through with just a hint of new-French-oak vanilla. But what really separates this wine from a classic French style is the depth of the palate and the inclusion of Malbec. The cherry and dark berry essence flows beautifully into the mid-palate while the mountain-grown tannins provide the structure supporting the lingering finish.
