The History

Agriculture was always part of the family history that's farming, arboriculture and viticulture. Marc MANOA, Roland's great-grandfather was a farmer he cultivated vineyards in the town of Pelussin, made wine and had a dairy farm. Charles GRANGIER, Roland's father, after a few years on the farm of his brother-in-law, settled on the municipality of Chavanay by creating a farm in polyculture (vines and fruit trees).

In 2002 Roland GRANGIER created domain Grangier and resumed the vines of the parents with a neighbor, grows by plantations in Saint Joseph White, Red St. Joseph and Condrieu to destine the area to the exclusive culture of the vine.

After two years of work, 2012 Roland and Céline GRANGIER moved into a new cellar. A winery, a winery and a tasting room was built.

The Vineyard

The estate is located in Chavanay in the northern sides of the Rhone, in the heart of the Regional Natural Park of Pilat. Roland GRANGIER cultivates and vinifies 9 ha distributed over two appellations of Condrieu, St. Joseph, and wines from countries.
